MUSEUM GUIDELINES

IN RESPONSE TO ONGOING CORONAVIRUS (COVID-19)
CONCERNS, WE ASK THAT ALL VISITORS COMPLY WITH THE
FOLLOWING GUIDELINES WHILE VISITING THE MUSEUM:

- A reservation is required for all tours
- Masks must be worn throughout museum
- Do not enter if you are feeling unwell, have a cough, fever or shortness of breath
- Use hand sanitizer and glove stations set up near museum interactives
- Maintain a physical distance of 6 feet or more
- Tours are limited to 10 individuals per party
- Tour times are limited to 90 minutes per party (if you are in need of additional time or accommodations, please contact museum staff)
